NOTE: Look in your download folder for a file called vMedia_install.exe. If it exists, continue to **Part A**: **vMedia Setup Wizard**.

NOTE: If you can't locate vMedia_install.exe, download the vMedia software again, by following the instructions below.

- 1. Open vertican.com/Login and log in.
- 2. Click on [My Vertican].
- 3. Click [My Products].
- 4. Click on [vMedia].
- 5. Click on the [Download vMedia] link.




Part A: vMedia Setup Wizard

NOTE: The vMedia software download placed the vmedia install.exe file in your Download folder.

- 1. Run vMedia install.exe to open the installer.
- 2. Run the vMedia Setup Wizard and follow the prompts.



3. While running the vMedia Setup Wizard, follow the prompts and accept any firewall related prompts or existing installation prompts to continue the setup.



4. Click [Finish].

Part B: Establish User Licenses - Assign Employees

- 1. Run the LicenseManager.exe file from the root drive of your vMedia application.
- 2. Enter your log in credentials and click [Login].




3. Click on a product to manage the license.




NOTE: Once you are granted access to the product editing screen, you must assign at least one user to the ADMINISTRATOR tier prior to saving the changes with the Save option. The system will not let you save any changes to the user list unless this condition is met.

- 4. Ensure that your subscription information in lower left corner matches what was purchased
- 5. Click on [Add New User]. (The other options are unavailable until you add the initial user.)

NOTE: You must assign at least one user to the ADMINISTRATOR tier.



- 6. Enter the user credentials.
 - User name must be the user's network login name.
 - Password is optional and does not need to be the same as the user's network password.




NOTE: If you attempt to add more users than the available amount, the Licenses grid will display a red indication and show the actual Assigned amount; but, it will adjust the Available amount accordingly. The over-assignment must be corrected before the changes can be saved.

- 7. Add any additional users and assign the appropriate tier to each user.
- 8. Click [Save] then click [X] to return to the project management menu.
- 9. Click on the [X] to exit the license manager.


Part C- Workstation Setup (Must be network administrator.)

NOTE: Run Workstation_Setup.exe on each workstation.


- 1. Open the root folder where vMedia is installed.
- 2. Locate and run Workstation_Setup.exe.
- 3. Click [Yes] to the *Read Existing Configuration Settings* prompt.




4. Run the vMedia Workstation Client Setup Wizard.




NOTE: The vMedia Workstation client MUST be installed to C:\IMASTER, regardless of where your vMedia program is installed.



5. Select a configuration ID.



6. Select or deselect any scanners as appropriate.
